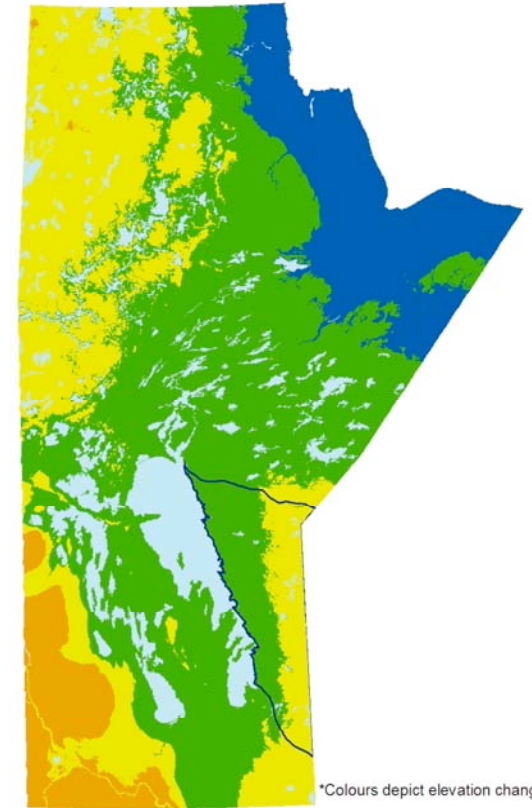

THE REPORT TOOLS

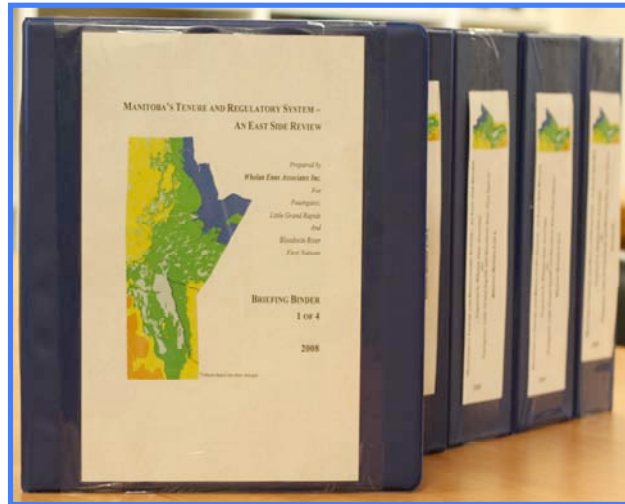
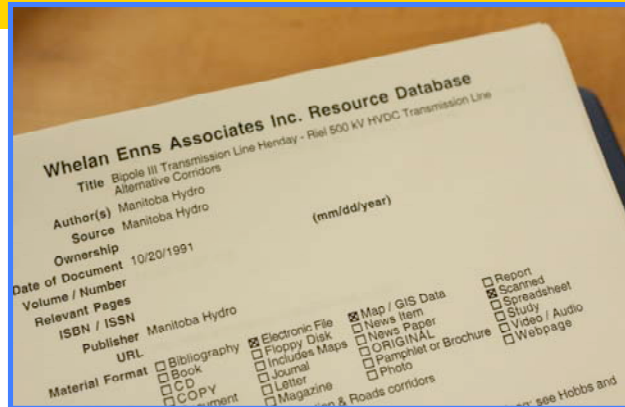
The Manitoba Tenure and Regulatory System **Tenure Tools** are a collection of products and research materials about lands and waters Tenure in Manitoba.

The **Introductory Sections** explain various parts of the project; **10 Report Chapters**, about different types of Tenure; with the "**Digital Research Workbooks**" focus on tenure types. These include: land designations, protection, roads, corridors, energy, townsites, forestry, tourism, mining, treaty, water, wildlife and project licensing. A **glossary of terms**, map collection, tenure Acts, guides for use of all tenure tools, and the digital research workbooks are included. The **Tenure Report** provides information about permits, dispositions, licenses and regulatory steps, decision-making authorities, legislation, and public policy in Manitoba regarding lands and water tenure.

CUSTOMIZING THE TENURES TOOLS

The first version of the Tenure Tools focus on East Side Manitoba Tenure and Regulatory Systems. Whelan Enns Associates conducted the research and briefing binders and data collection; products are compiled in our office.

Customizing of these Tenure Tools is possible for any location or region in Manitoba. A variety of tenure chapters can be added, removed, enhanced or expanded depending on (for example) geographic location, surrounding infrastructure, relevant regulations and community concerns.



DATABASE

The Whelan Enns Associates Inc. Resource Database records and tracks all resources relevant to our clients. The database includes records for historic, technical, books, interviews, survey maps and other materials. BRIEFING BINDERS
